

Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten & Gold ("3TG") — Polyethylene Foam & Cardboard Packaging Materials

SCOPE

This statement covers the polyethylene foam and cardboard packaging materials manufactured and supplied by Edline Advanced Packaging Solutions ("Edline"). It addresses customer requests concerning conflict minerals — tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold ("3TG") — under Section 1502 of the U.S. Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act and Regulation (EU) 2017/821 on supply chain due diligence for importers of tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold from conflict-affected and high-risk areas.

DECLARATION

Edline confirms that its polyethylene foam and cardboard packaging materials do not contain, and are not manufactured with, tin, tantalum, tungsten or gold in any form. These metals are not constituents of, and are not used in, the production of polyethylene foam or corrugated cardboard — Edline's raw materials are limited to polyethylene resin and paper-based fibre. Edline is accordingly not an "Importer" of tin, tantalum, tungsten ores or gold as defined in Annex I of Regulation (EU) 2017/821, and has no supply-chain due-diligence obligation under that regulation.

IMPORTANT CLARIFICATION — DECLARATION VS. CMRT

Note: This document is Edline's own conflict-minerals declaration and is not the standardised Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) published by the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI). Where a customer specifically requires the CMRT format — typically used in electronics supply chains — Edline can complete that template instead; the underlying answer is the same, as no 3TG is present in Edline's materials.

- Corrugated cardboard (carton)

This statement reflects Edline's current knowledge of its materials and production process, is provided in good faith, and does not constitute a laboratory test report or an audited supply-chain due-diligence report. It remains valid until superseded or until the underlying materials or production process change.
